

Umrah & Holy Land Tour Starting & Finish in Friday

15 Days / 14 Nights

Day 1: Arrival to Amman International airport. Meeting and assistance. Transfer to Amman hotel dinner and overnight.

Day 2: After breakfast you will leave the Hotel & going to be Amman City Tour including a visit to the Citadel, Umayyad Palace, and the Jordan Archeological Museum JAM, after the tour you will visit the cave of the cavemen.

Then you will have a visit to Al-Hussein Mosque in the Down town. It was built by king Abdullah in 1924 on the spot of



an ancient mosque (640 AD); also you will visit King Hussein Mosque (west of Amman). A picturesque site and huge building will win your heart. The mosque looks effective in the evening; there is also a historical museum which contains unique documents relating to the history of Islam. After the visit you will go to visit Jerash. Jerash is a mixture of the eastern and western culture. Everywhere there are signs of the ancient Greco-Roman Mediterranean culture and ancient Arabic traditions. Then back to Amman's Hotel for Dinner & Overnight.

Day 3: Breakfast at the Hotel, then transfer to King Hussein's border cross to Jerusalem.
